## **Historical Sketch**

The Stapleton Community Local Development Corporation was founded in 1979 in order to improve the socio-economic conditions of the Stapleton neighborhood in Staten Island, New York. This community organization was involved in the preservation of historic homes, the promotion of continuing education, and the support of local businesses.

## **Scope and Content**

The Stapleton Community Local Development Corporation Records contain material documenting the creation of the Corporation as well as the group's activities. The collection consists of two folders. Folder 1, **Founding Documents**, contains the constitution, by-laws and
